

PANEL RULES

There are a few simple instructions that all panel speakers and leaders must adhere to:

- **1.** Please identify as an alcoholic.
- 2. DO NOT give a prolonged drunk-a-log. Please share about recovery and living sober.
- **3.** DO NOT criticize the institution, personnel, facilities, policies or practices.
- 4. DO NOT give opinions on medication.
- 5. DO NOT talk down to the group, use profane or vulgar language.
- 6. Please abide by facility rules. This includes phone number exchange protocol.
- 7. COVID vaccination, masks and distancing are currently required on all panels. (No handshakes or hugs.)
- 8. Please dress appropriately for your panel. Business casual attire is suggested. Please DO NOT wear any revealing clothing, shorts, or sandals.
- 9. DO NOT bring any guests to the panel or use your phone during the panel.
- **10.** LA H&I has a zero tolerance policy for sexual harassment of any kind. This includes inappropriate conversations or behavior with facility staff or clients/inmates, or sexually suggestive sharing while speaking on a panel.
- **11.** DO NOT give referrals to any outside institution (rehab, sober living, etc.)

JAIL PANELS ONLY: (IMPORTANT!)

- **12.** All literature is temporarily prohibited in LA County Jails.
- **13.** DO NOT exchange phone numbers or messages with any inmate.
- **14.** Leave your cell phone in the car or check it into a locker.
